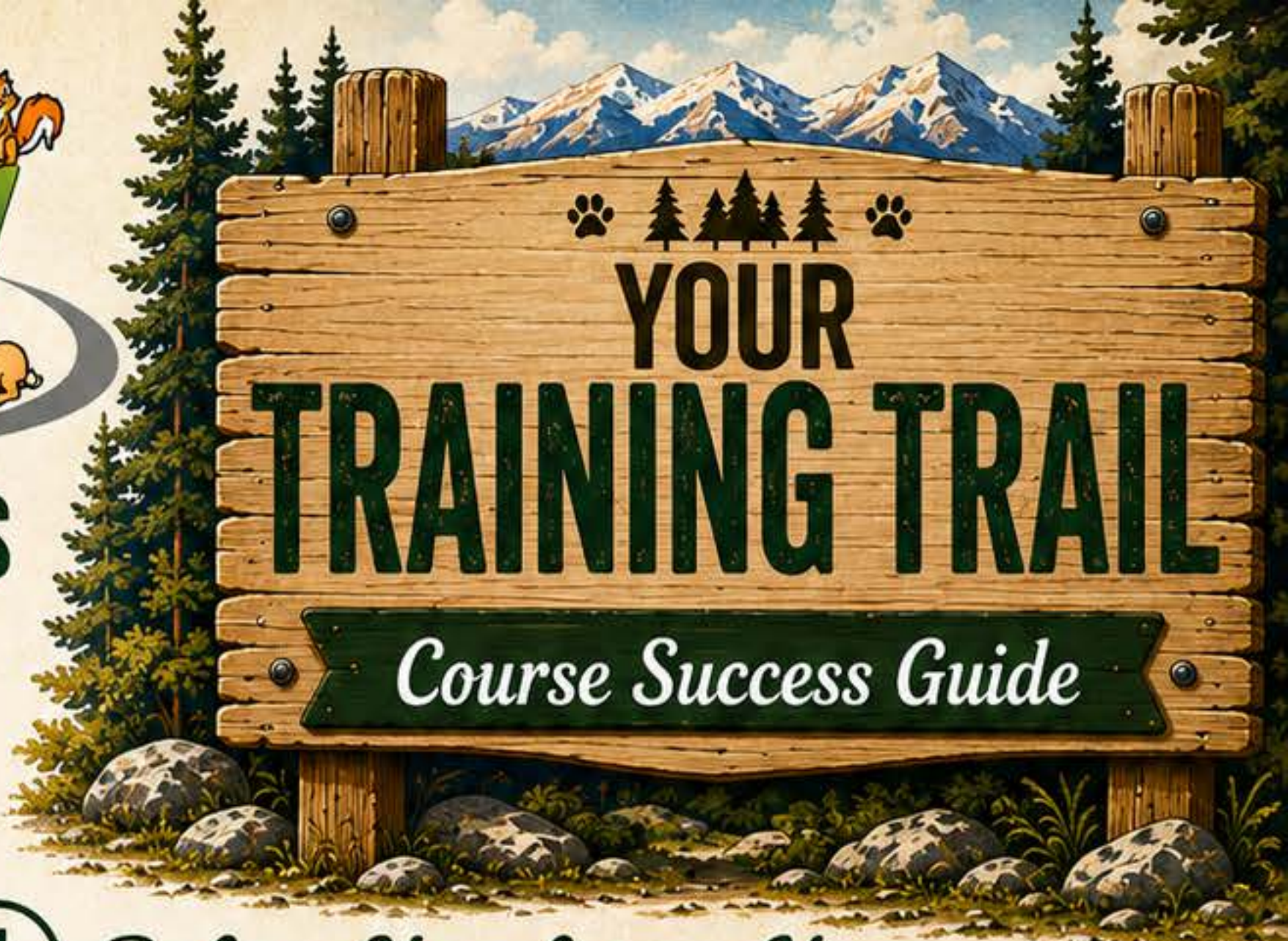




BEFORE EVERY CLASS

A quick checklist to help you and your dog arrive prepared, confident, and ready to learn.



1 Before You Leave Home

- ☒ Non-retractable leash (6 ft. maximum)
- ☒ Small, soft training treats (or part of their meal)
- ☒ Mat or towel for your dog
- ☒ Water for your dog (optional)
- ☒ Give your dog a potty break before class.
- ☒ Positive attitude and sense of fun!

2 When You Arrive

- ☒ Please arrive a few minutes early.
- ☒ Please wait near your assigned training room until your trainer invites your class inside.
- ☒ Please keep the doorway clear so departing classes can exit before your class enters.
- ☒ Give other dogs plenty of space—not every dog wants to visit.

3 During Class

- ☒ We primarily use positive reinforcement training methods that build confidence, strengthen your bond, and make learning fun.
- ☒ Ask permission from your trainer before allowing dogs to greet each other.
- ☒ Questions are always welcome—we're here to help!

4 TRAIL RULES



Each six-week session is for the class day and time you registered for.



Please review the Training Center calendar for all class dates and any breaks.



If you know you will miss more than one class, please consider delaying enrollment until the next session.

5 MAKE-UP CLASS



If you miss a class during your six-week session, you are welcome to attend the scheduled make-up class for your class type.



Everyone is welcome and encouraged to attend, whether you missed a class or not!

6 CANCELLATION POLICY



BEFORE CLASS BEGINS



Cancel at least 24 hours before your first class for a full refund.

AFTER CLASS BEGINS

- No refunds are provided once class begins.
- If your trainer determines another service would better suit your dog, store credit may be applied toward private lessons.

7 KIDS IN TRAINING



Children are always welcome!



An adult must accompany any child under 18.



Children under 10 must be accompanied by 2 adults—one focused on dog handling and one on child supervision.



Please help your child remain quiet and seated during class.
