CRICKET ACADEMY



COLLEGE RULES & DISCIPLINE

- 1. University Examination & Attendance: A student appearing at University/Board Examination must have minimum 75% of attendance in each subject as per Rules. A fine of Rs. 21- per lecture or Rs. 51- per day, whichever is less will be charged for remaining absent in the class without prior permission.
- 2. Students who do not have the prescribed percentage of attendance are liable to be detained from appearing at University Examination.
- 3. If a student remains absent in the class continuously for one month, his name can be removed from the roll of students of the college without any notice.
- 4. Every student shall abide by the instructions issued both in general as well as in special cases by the Principal and the Members of the Staff.
- 5. Students shall behave with decency with members of the Teaching and Non-Teaching staff and also their fellow students.
- 6. Student must remain present in their respective classes at the prescribed timings. No student shall attend classes other than his own or bring in the college premises any person who is not a student of this college.
- 7. While the teaching work is being carried in the college, loitering in the college corridor, individually or in the groups is strictly prohibited. Off periods may be spent in Library reading room
- 8. A student suffering from any infectious or contagious disease shall not attend college unless he/she is medically fit.
- 9. A student must always put on his college identity card and produce the same when required by the authorities.
- 10. While getting the books issued from library, the identity card must have to be produced at the counter.
- 11. The library books must be handled property and returned on the dates specified to avoid fine. A fine of Rs. 1.00 will be charged for each day if delayed.
- 12. A student shall maintain a quiet and congenial atmosphere in the college during the teaching and office hours. Any student disturbing the atmosphere shall be liable for strict disciplinary action, including suspension from the college.
- 13. Anti-ragging code laid down by Supreme Court makes ragging a criminal offence. FIR will be lodged against those who indulge in ragging.
- 14. Student shall participate in all the functions organized by the College and also in the test examinations conducted by the college. A fine of Rs. 50/- will be charged for absence in test & viva-voce.
- 15. Every student shall make a proper use of College building furniture and electricity. Any student found guilty of causing damage to the property or found guilty of scrubbing or pasting posters on the walls, blackboard shall be expelled from the college and the damage to the property will be recovered from him. General losses and damage to the college property during the year shall be assessed at the end of the session and recovered from students of all classes.
- 16. Any change in permanent as well as local address of a student must be brought to the notice of college forthwith in writing.
- 17. No student shall use Mobile Phone in the College premises.

- 18. No student will be allowed to interfere in the administration of the college.
- 19. No student shall directly send anything concerning the college for publication either to the press or else where without the prior approval of the concerned authorities. Any breach of this rule may entail outright expulsion of the student from the college.
- 20. Elections of University Students Council shall be held as per the provisions and directives from the R.T.M. Nagpur University.
- 21. No student shall involve himself in teasing or ragging of any other student in the college/hostel. Students found doing so shall be punished/expelled from the college.
- 22. Only important notices shall be read out in classrooms. Students are therefore, expected to read the Notices that may be put up on the Notice Board from time to time. No individual notices regarding examination dates, filling of examination forms etc. will be given.
- 23. Students found indulging in activities which are not in the interest of the college and are detrimental to the smooth functioning of the college, shall be expelled from the college. Right of giving Transfer certificate or expelling the student from the college in reserved with the Principal.
- 24. Internal Assessment marks are given on the basis' of classroom attendance, test examination, home assignment & Viva-voce.
- 25. All students of Degree College shall appear for terminal exams viva voce, physical and medical exam as per University rules. Students committing default will be fined heavily.
- 26. Smoking, use of drugs, alcohol, liquor, pan masala, gutkha and tobacco are strictly prohibited in the college premises. Strict action of outright expulsion of the student from the college will be effected
- 27. In case of cancellation of admission of any course, the fees paid, shall be refundable as per the norms prescribed by the competent authority.
- 28. As per the direction and provisions of R. T. M. Nagpur University, the college will have no elected class representatives, president and secretary of student's council.
- 29 Students must park their vehicles in the allotted parking area only. Any loss or damage to the vehicle will not be entertained by the college.
- 30. Students should not carry any belongings inside the reading room and will have to show identity card to the library staff. He will maintain complete silence in library.
- 31. The exam schedule and vacations will be granted as per the directions of R.T. M. Nagpur University Nagpur.
- 32. As per the guidelines & rules of Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University, incentive marks (maximum 10) for the students with outstanding performance in NCC, NSS, Sports, Cultural and Continuing, Adult Education and Extension activities will be given.
- 33. Parents Teachers Meet: The college organise Parents Teacher's meet twice in a year to facilitate vital discussion on the performance, progress and achievements of the students.
- 34. **Special instruction for scholarship holders**: The scholarship holders should submit hard copy of scholarship form filled online in college office to the concerning clerk and should take acknowledgment on the admission receipt. He should if preserve till scholarship is received. College in no way be held responsible if this is not followed strictly.
