





But many homes - especially homes in new neighborhoods or in certain geographic regions - lack shade trees. How are you supposed to temper the intensity of the sun's rays if you lack trees? Sail shades reduce heat by up to 30%, while the breathable fabric allows breezes to pass through and prevents rain from accumulating on the shade.

Pulling off a game-ready gathering for your friends and family is simple with these tailgating essentials.






SETTING THE SCENE:


Set out plenty of chairs for your guests. Arrange them in small half-circles to encourage conversation. Hammocks swaying between trees, chaise lounges by the pool, and wooden porch swings will all come in handy for guests who need to rest during extended revelry. Picnic tables draped in tablecloths (in the colors of your team, of course!) and big metal tubs full of ice, soda, and bottled water create an atmosphere of casual hospitality and fun.



WATCHING THE GAME:

While some guests like to tailgate simply for the pleasure of good grub and friends, others prioritize actually watching the game. A backyard tailgate can easily flow inside for guests to tune in to the action in your living room or media room. Even better, install a TV on your covered patio, where you'll be able to keep one eye on the grill and the other on the gridiron. For a unique tailgate spin, make a splash with dive-in game watching. Set up a projector to broadcast the game on an inflatable screen within view of your pool. A Bluetooth speaker, a floating cooler, and plenty of colorful floats for lounging are all you need to watch the game from the luxury of your pool.







PLAYING AROUND: TAILGATE LAWN GAMES:

Whether you're tailgating during a playoff game or a preseason scrimmage, watching sports tends to bring out the competitive spirit in many people. Take advantage of guests' urge to play by setting up a few lawn and pool games. Try cornhole and volleyball for the yard and floating basketball and ring toss for the water. If you have a ping pong or foosball table, wheel those out for easy access. And make sure to inflate basketballs and footballs for pickup games -purchase a flag football set and a set of scrimmage jerseys to outfit your competition in style.



SNACKING SATISFACTION:

Let your outdoor kitchen shine during a backyard tailgate with a barbecue. Even a simple charcoal grill can turn out stacks of mouthwatering burgers while a brick oven can crank out custom woodfired pizzas. Whatever your game day menu, keep food simple and decadent. Sticking to small portions allows guests to sample a variety of snacks and keep coming back for more. To show extra courtesy to guests, provide snack options for dietary restrictions in the crowd (gluten-free, vegetarian, etc.) even if most of your dishes are meat- and bread-centric. While hot dogs are time-tested, don't be afraid to branch out a little bit with these game-day eats.



4 GREAT TAILGATE RECIPIES

1. MEXICAN STREET CORN DIP:

A spin on the Mexican classic, this Mexican Street Corn Dip combines the crunch of corn with the gooey richness of cheese and sharp tang of lime. Set out plenty of tortilla chips and watch this dip dwindle.

INGREDIENTS:

- . 16oz. (3 1/2 cup) frozen or fresh corn, roasted
- ½ cup queso fresco
- · 1/4 cup grated parmesan cheese
- · 1/2 diced red onion
- · 1 diced poblano pepper
- ½ cup mayonnaise or yogurt
- · 1/4 cup fresh cilantro
- · 1 clove minced garlic
- . 1/2 lime, zested and juiced
- ½ teaspoon chili powder
- ½ teaspoon salt

DIRECTIONS:

Whisk together yogurt, lime zest and juice, and 1/4 teaspoon salt. Set aside.

Toss roasted corn with chili powder, pepper, onion, and garlio in a medium bowl.

Stir in lime-yogurt mixture, queso fresco, half of the Parmesan and 1/4 teaspoon salt.

Transfer to a serving dish and top with oilantro, remaining Parmesan, and a sprinkle of chili powder.





2. ULTIMATE **GRILLED CHEESE BAR:**

Set out a variety of bread, shredded cheeses, and meat and vegetable toppings. Fire up the grill and let your guests build their own custom grilled cheese sandwiches. The tasty concoctions will prove once and for all that grilled cheese is perfectly suitable for grown-ups too.

3. QUICK AND EASY **BUFFALO CHICKEN DIP:**

INGREDIENTS:

- · 1 package (8 ounces) cream cheese, softened
- · 1 cup cooked chicken breast
- · 1/2 cup Buffalo wing sauce
- · 1/2 cup ranch or blue cheese salad dressing
- · 2 cups shredded Colby-Monterey Jack or cheddar cheese
- · Tortilla chips, baquettes, crackers, or celery

DIRECTIONS:

Preheat oven to 350°. Spread cream cheese into an ungreased shallow 1-qt. baking dish. Layer with chicken, wing sauce and salad dressing. Sprinkle with cheese.

Bake, uncovered, 20-26 minutes or until cheese is melted. Serve with chips, baguettes, crackers, or celery.





4. DESSERT BAR:

Display bite-sized desserts related to your tailgating theme. Decorate brownies or crispy rice treats to look like footballs or frost a cake in the colors of your team. Hand out homemade popsicles and ice cream cones for a quick way to cool down during a toasty tailgate.

5. APPLE HAND PIES: INGREDIENTS:

- · 2 pie crusts
- · 2 tablespoons freshly squeezed lemon juice
- · 3 pounds baking apples
- · 2/3 cup sugar, plus more for sprinkling on the pie
- · 1/4 cup unsalted butter
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- · 1/4 teaspoon ground nutmeg
- · 1 large egg, lightly beaten
- · 1 tablespoon milk

DIRECTIONS:

Peel and dice the apples. Toss apples with lemon juice and sugar.

Melt butter over mediumhigh heat in a skillet. Add apples and spices and cook for 2 minutes, stirring, until it begins to simmer. Set mixture aside to cool.

Roll out the dough and out the edges. into circles with a 3 inch cookie cutter or jar lid. Refrigerate out oircles until filling is cool.

Preheat oven to 375 and line baking sheets with parchment paper.

Arrange half the dough circles, spaced apart, on baking sheets. Cut slits in the other circles (to vent). Scoop a few tablespoons of filling into the center of each dough circle. Place slit circle on top and crimp

Combine egg and milk with a fork. Brush pies with egg wash and sprinkle with sugar. Bake pies for 30 minutes or until golden brown.






In many areas, backyards can be enjoyed throughout the entire year.







Travertine

is the most widely used natural stone - forming around hot springs and in wet caves. It has a very coarse texture with many holes created by air bubbles and living organisms trapped in the rock. It can be several different colors depending on which minerals have penetrated it, including white, yellow, beige, or red. Travertine can be found all over the world, but the most popular source is Tivoli, Italy. The Romans first used it as a building material for temples, monuments and amphitheaters.

It is available in multiple dimensions, shapes and finishes. It is very easy to maintain, and the rich tones enhance its natural beauty.





Quartzite

is a hard, non-layered rock which originated as sandstone but has been converted through heating and pressure. It is extremely dense and resists chemical weathering. It can be polished to a high-gloss finish yet is non-slippery and can be used in commercial application.

Quartzite can be found all over the world and can vary in color from the common white/gray to pink, red, yellow, green, blue and orange.





Flagstone

is most often used in building and landscaping. Because it is split into thin layers, it can be used in many applications. It can be quarried in many places, including Texas, Arizona, Oklahoma, Arkansas and even the Western Coast of Ireland. The colors most commonly found are red, pink, peach, chocolate and beige.

It is ideally used in a range of projects because it comes in a variety of colors, is widely available, is durable, and has a natural non-slip surface. It's often used in paving, bench seats, roofing and fences.







is an organic rock formed from the accumulation of shell, coral, and algae. It is mostly formed in shallow, warm water. Because of impurities such as clay, sand, organic remains and other materials, Limestone can exhibit different colors - especially on weathered surfaces. 





Swimming pool technology has improved exponentially in the last two decades.

While most of these changes make your pool cleaner, safer, and easier to maintain, advancements in pool finish have made a more noticeable effect because they change the look and feel of your swimming pool.

To understand the new generation of pool finishes, we first need to understand how they came about.

The swimming pool boom began during the economic shift following World War II.

Glamorized by Hollywood, swimming pools were becoming affordable thanks to the growing middle class and a new application technique, pneumatically applied concrete, or gunite. Back then, pools were typically painted white, which was pleasing to the eye, but required reapplication every few years and contained lead and copper. Also around this time, cheaper alternatives to concrete pools came about that didn't require finishing, such as above ground and fiberglass shell pools, but concrete pools were still the most common.







The industry moved to plaster,

which offered extra durability, but was still prone to damage and discoloration from poorly balanced water. Chemical enhancements make today's plaster finishes hardier than previous versions, but the biggest innovation in finish tech came in the late 1980's with the advent of aggregate finishes.



Gunite pools give you the most flexibility with the appearance of your pool.

Generally, pool plaster tends to erode over time. This causes the pool surface to cut, scrape, and scratch the skin. A pool plaster finish typically lasts between 5 and 10 years. This figure is all based on proper water chemistry and maintenance. For pool owners that want or need to remodel their plaster, there are new types of pool finishes that offer new looks and extended life.


Aggregate swimming pool finishes have been growing in popularity over the last few decades.

Today, they have taken the top spot from pool plaster as the most desirable pool finish option. Aggregate pool finishes contain river pebbles, stones, ceramic-coated crystals, or glass, which are combined with Portland cement-based pigmented plaster and applied pneumatically. Most pool owners have chosen to go with an aggregate pool finish because of its durability and visual appeal. Companies such as NPT® offer a wide array of pool finishes with different aggregates.

The recent trend toward an aggregate pool finish over pool plaster will add life to any swimming pool. Exposed aggregate pool finishes incorporate stones, pebbles, and/or glass beads into the pool plaster to add resilience and aesthetic qualities. Because of this, aggregate finishes are more resistant to pool chemical imbalances than other finishes and last much longer.

Exposed aggregate pool finishes have been shown to have a lifespan of between 15 and 20 years.








Pool Coping?

Pool Coping - Coping is a word that derives from the Latin cappa (like cap), and serves as the cover for the interior frame of inground pools. It protects swimmers from exposed metal and adds a decorative frame to a pool. Coping, usually made of brick, natural or handcrafted stone, or concrete integrates the pool finish and tile with the surrounding hardscape. Coping comes in the following styles:

Travertine | Flagstone | Marble | Porcelain | Concrete Pavers | Precast | Clay | Concrete







> Here are ten tips to help you get the backyard you crave.





#1:

Break It Up

While it seems counter intuitive to divide an already-small yard, well-defined spaces will actually make it seem bigger.

Create a grilling nook with angled pavers, use a linear fountain to separate the play section, or create an outdoor dining room with an herb-covered garden wall. The more unique spaces you have, the bigger your yard will appear.



#2:

Think Outside of the Box

When most people design patios or decks, they envision boxy, square or rectangular spaces and straight lines. But if you want your space to look larger, think diagonally. By installing your pavers and decking diagonally, you'll elongate the area.





#3:

Take the Long Way

Create the illusion of depth by designing walkways to wind around the yard instead of heading straight to the destination.

Even better, narrow them as they reach the farthest point; this tricks the eye into believing it's farther away than it really is.



#4:

Create a Grand Entrance

An arbor, pergola, or trellis covered in greenery can make your small space appear larger. These features, especially at the entrance, trick the eye into believing that the space is larger than it really is.

Because this feature acts as a "door" to your grand space, make sure it's wow-worthy.

#5:

Use Color Wisely

Another way to fool the eye is to use bright colors at the entrance of your yard, which makes the rest of it recede.

For example, if you plan to use a trellis as the entrance, get more from it by planting tall, colorful plants in front of it.



#6:

Don't Be Level-Headed

Most backyards are level, and this comes in handy when planning a swimming pool or outdoor kitchen. But if your goal is to make your space appear larger, think about adding levels to your yard. They can be as simple as a sunken patio or as elaborate as stair-stepped gardens that reach the top of your fence.





#7:

Use Focal Points Strategically

Every great backyard has at least one stunning focal point, but if you're trying to make yours look bigger, you should place it at the back of the yard. Doing this creates an optical illusion because the eye has to "travel" across the yard to land on the focal point at the back of the space.



#8:

Use Mirrors

When you want to increase the look of an indoor space, mirrors are a great way to do it. And today's backyard enthusiasts are taking the tried-and-true trick outdoors. Look for sturdy mirrors made of stone, wood, copper, or steel so they won't deteriorate in the outdoor weather, and then hang them strategically to reflect light and enlarge the feel of your backyard space.

#9:

Look Up

Building vertical features will also help your small backyard look larger. Build tall fences, use bamboo partitions for walls that separate backyard "rooms," or add tall steel structures, statues, or pool waterfalls to add some height to your space. When guests have to look up to see the entire yard, they will imagine that it's bigger than it is.



#10:

Don't Stray from the House Design

Finally, if you want make your small backyard appear larger, let the design elements overflow from the house to the backyard space. For example, if your home is decorated in Mediterranean style, continue the flow from the interior to the exterior. If people see the yard as an extension of the house, it will make it appear larger because it will seem as if it's an extension of the same space.


