

NOTICE OF VOTE TO THE ELECTORS OF THE WENDAT NATION

GENERAL ELECTION OF OCTOBER 30TH, 2026

SECTION I - PURPOSE OF THE NOTICE

Wendake, August 21st, 2026

On Friday, October 30th, 2026, electors of the Wendat Nation will be called upon to vote to elect four (4) Chiefs to the Council of the Wendat Nation.

This Notice of vote is issued in accordance with section 67 of the *Code électoral*, an integral part of *Onywatenda'yerahtih de akhrihontha'* (*Code de représentation de la Nation Wendat*) (hereinafter referred to as the "**Code électoral**").

SECTION II - VOTING PROCEDURE

Who may vote?

On polling day, every elector, in order to be entitled to vote, must be entered on the electoral list¹ and be able to confirm their identity and Indian Status Certificate number.

How to vote?

Three voting methods will be available to electors:

1. Mail-in voting (see Section III)
2. Mobile voting, if the elector meets the eligibility criteria (see Section IV)
3. Voting at the polling station (see Section V)

An elector may use only one voting method. Therefore, any elector who exercises their right to vote by mail or through mobile voting shall not be entitled to vote on polling day.

Electors may cast their vote by using an x, +, √, or by completely filling in the space on the ballot for a maximum of four (4) candidates for the position of Chief.

SECTION III – MAIL-IN VOTING PROCEDURES

The mail-in voting kit is available upon request made directly to the Chief Electoral Officer. It will be available following the nomination meeting, once the identity of the candidates is known, thereby allowing ballots to be printed.

SECTION IV - MOBILE VOTING PROCEDURES

When will mobile voting take place?

The mobile voting period will take place from October 15th to October 18th, 2026⁵.

What are the eligibility criteria for mobile voting?

To be eligible for mobile voting, an elector must reside in Wendake or in the City of Québec, L'Ancienne-Lorette, or Saint-Augustin-de-Desmaures, and must have submitted a request to the Chief Electoral Officer using the contact information provided in Section VIII of this notice **no later than October 14th, 2026**.

The elector must also:

- a) Be accommodated in a facility maintained by an institution operating a hospital centre, a long-term care and residential centre, a rehabilitation centre within the meaning of the *Act Respecting the Governance of the Health and Social Services System*, or a reception centre;
- b) Have temporarily left their residence to receive health care, participate in a rehabilitation program, or ensure their own safety or that of their children;
- c) Be unable to travel.

SECTION V – VOTING AT THE POLLING STATION

Polling will take place on Friday, October 30th, 2026, from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., in the SOCCA Hall of the Centre sportif Desjardins de Wendake, located at 100, rue Ennonweh /rue des Femmes (formerly known as "Grand Chief Thonnakona Street"), Wendake, Québec, G0A 4V0.

Accommodation measures will be provided for persons with disabilities. For any questions in this regard, please contact the Chief Electoral Officer.

SECTION VI - THE ELECTORAL LIST

How can an elector verify their registration on the electoral list?

In compliance with the *Politique du Conseil de la Nation Wendat relative à la confidentialité et à la protection des renseignements personnels concernant les membres, les utilisateurs du site Web et les candidat·e·s*, the electoral list will neither be publicly posted in Wendake nor made available on the Nation's website⁶.

IMPORTANT: Any elector who has not received their Notice of vote shall have until noon on October 15th, 2026⁷, to contact the Chief Electoral Officer to verify their registration on the electoral list. For any request to revise the electoral list, please refer to Section VII of this notice.

SECTION VII - REVISION OF THE ELECTORAL LIST

Any elector may request a revision of the electoral list:

- a) To register an elector;
- b) To correct information concerning an elector;
- c) For the removal of an elector who is ineligible to vote under the Code électoral or a deceased elector.

Electors must use the form provided for this purpose, available on the Council's website. A paper copy will also be available from the Chief Electoral Officer.

IMPORTANT: Any person who is not entered on the electoral list at the conclusion of the revision period will not be permitted to vote.
