
Benchmark IT Tech Spend in 2022








Percentage experiencing budget impacts to date due to COVID-19

COVID-19 continues to drive up cloud spend and drive down on-premises software spend. Organizations turn to SaaS and move more apps and data to the cloud to support remote employees. These trends are continuing as budgets for items more directly related to enabling a remote work force increase, such as SaaS (69%), public cloud (59%) and desktop/laptops (55%). Conversely, spending associated with legacy office environments had decreased, such as data centers (-27%), servers (-28%) and on-premises software (-27%).






The vast majority expect their IT budgets to increase in the next year, regardless of their region of the world.

Planned changes to use external IT resources

The top five areas in which external partners will play a supplemental role are:

- 1. Cybersecurity
- 2. Big Data/analytics
- 3. Cloud operations
- 4. Al/machine learning
- 5. Automation

All five are rapidly growing areas requiring specialized skill sets.
