- Conducting research and publication activities and representing the university within the scientific community
- Securing external funding and contributing to the university's research profile
- Teaching in related degree programs at the university, where required

You demonstrate excellent academic quality in teaching and research

- Relevant university degree in health sciences, public health, health economics, or a related health profession
- Completed doctorate
- Expertise and professional experience in at least one area of digital health applications, such as telemedicine, teletherapy, artificial intelligence, augmented reality (AR), virtual reality (VR), robotics, or health-related applications/apps
- At least 5 years of professional experience (fully documented), including at least 3 years outside the higher education sector (in accordance with the appointment requirements for professorships pursuant to § 100(1) BerlHG)
- Proven pedagogical aptitude demonstrated through teaching experience at a higher education institution
- Demonstrated scholarly expertise through peer-reviewed publications and conference presentations
- Experience in research projects and acquisition of external funding is desirable
- Willingness to engage in interdisciplinary collaboration
- Experience in the use of digital learning technologies in higher education teaching is desirable
- Excellent command of English, demonstrated through teaching experience, academic work in English, international publications, or equivalent professional experience; alternatively, a bachelor's degree completed in English
- Instruction is conducted in English; candidates without German language proficiency are expected to demonstrate willingness to gradually acquire basic German language skills
- Interest and enthusiasm for educating and supporting young people

For the role of program leader, business-level proficiency in both written and spoken German and English is required.
