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A Note to Parents and Teachers

This book was written to help young Muslim children, under the age of ten, learn the essential knowledge of Islam through simple, friendly Questions and Answers. Each chapter opens with a short list of what the child will learn, is followed by easy Q&A, and closes with a Remember box highlighting the key idea.

Diagrams are used to explain processes such as Wudu, Salah and Hajj. Duas, the Kalimas and Islamic vocabulary are presented with Arabic text, transliteration and easy English meanings. Quick Quizzes follow each Part, worksheets are provided for extra practice, and a Final Islamic Knowledge Exam with an Answer Key appears at the end of the book.

Parents and teachers are encouraged to read each chapter together with the child, discuss the Q&A aloud, and use the worksheets and quizzes for gentle revision rather than pressure or testing.

Q7. Is Allah powerful?

Answer: Yes, Allah is Most Powerful. He can do anything.

Q8. What are Allah's beautiful names called?

Answer: They are called Al-Asma-ul-Husna, the Most Beautiful Names of Allah.

Q9. Name one beautiful name of Allah.

Answer: Ar-Rahman, which means the Most Merciful.

Q10. Why should we love Allah?

Answer: We should love Allah because He created us and gives us everything we need.

Q11. How can we thank Allah?

Answer: We thank Allah by saying Alhamdulillah and by obeying Him.

Q12. Should we trust Allah?

Answer: Yes, we should always trust Allah because He knows what is best for us.

Allah has 99 beautiful names, and Muslims love to learn and say them.

Answer: Islam means submitting and obeying Allah, and it also means peace.

Q2. Who is a Muslim?

Answer: A Muslim is a person who believes in Allah and follows the teachings of Islam.

Q3. What does a Muslim believe in?

Answer: A Muslim believes in Allah, His Angels, His Books, His Messengers, the Last Day, and that everything good and bad happens by Allah's will.

Q4. Whom do Muslims obey?

Answer: Muslims obey Allah and follow the teachings of Prophet Muhammad ﷺ.

Q5. Does Islam teach peace?

Answer: Yes, Islam teaches peace, kindness and good behaviour with everyone.

Q6. Is Islam only about prayers?

Answer: No, Islam is a complete way of life that guides how we eat, speak, play and treat others.

Q7. Who brought the message of Islam to us?

Answer: Prophet Muhammad ﷺ brought the final message of Islam to all people.

Q8. Why do Muslims follow Islam?

Answer: Muslims follow Islam because it is the true religion sent by Allah to guide us to happiness in this life and the next.

CHAPTER 3

THE FIVE PILLARS OF ISLAM

Answer: The first pillar is Shahadah, the declaration of faith.

Answer: The second pillar is Salah, the five daily prayers.

Q4. What is the third pillar?

Answer: The third pillar is Zakat, giving charity to the poor.

Q5. What is the fourth pillar?

Answer: The fourth pillar is Sawm, fasting in the month of Ramadan.

Q6. What is the fifth pillar?

Answer: The fifth pillar is Hajj, the pilgrimage to Makkah once in a lifetime if a person is able.

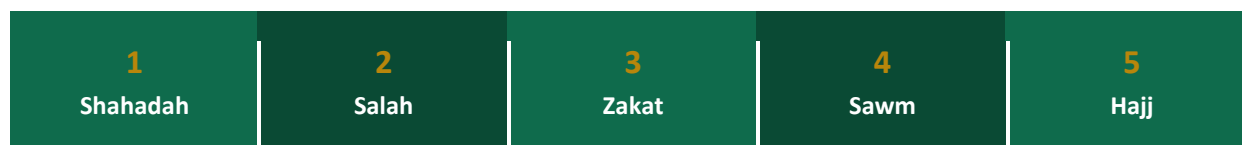
Q7. Why are they called 'pillars'?

Answer: They are called pillars because, like pillars hold up a building, they hold up a Muslim's life and faith.

Q8. Do all Muslims try to follow the five pillars?

Answer: Yes, every Muslim tries their best to follow all five pillars.

Answer: Kalimah Tayyibah - the Kalimah of Purity.

Answer: There is no god but Allah, and Muhammad ﷺ is the Messenger of Allah.

Q3. What is the Second Kalimah called?

Answer: Kalimah Shahadah - the Kalimah of Testimony.

Q4. What is the Third Kalimah called?

Answer: Kalimah Tamjeed - the Kalimah of Glorification of Allah.

Second Kalimah - Shahadah	أَشْهَدُ أَنْ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ...	Ash-hadu an la ilaha illallah...	I bear witness that there is no god but Allah, and that Muhammad ﷺ is His servant and Messenger.
Third Kalimah - Tamjeed	سُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ وَالْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ...	Subhanallahi wal hamdulillahi...	Glory is to Allah, and praise is to Allah; there is no god but Allah, and Allah is the Greatest.

Fourth Kalimah - Tawheed	لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ...	La ilaha illallahu wahdahu la sharika lah...	There is no god but Allah alone, with no partner; His is the kingdom, and His is all praise.
Fifth Kalimah - Astighfar	أَسْتَغْفِرُ اللَّهَ رَبِّي مِنْ كُلِّ ذَنْبٍ...	Astaghfirullah Rabbi min kulli dhambiw...	I ask forgiveness from Allah, my Lord, from every sin I committed.
Sixth Kalimah - Radde Kufr	اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَعُوذُ بِكَ...	Allahumma inni a'udhu bika...	O Allah, I seek refuge in You from associating any partner with You.

WUDU AND CLEANLINESS

WUDU

What will I learn?

- What Wudu is and why we do it
- The steps of Wudu

Q1. What is Wudu?

Answer: Wudu is washing certain parts of the body in a special way before prayer.

Q2. Why do we perform Wudu?

Answer: We perform Wudu to be clean and pure before standing in front of Allah in prayer.

Q3. When do we need Wudu?

Answer: We need Wudu before every Salah and to touch the Qur'an.

Q4. What do we say before starting Wudu?

Answer: We say Bismillah (In the name of Allah).

Q5. Which parts of the body do we wash in Wudu?

Answer: Hands, mouth, nose, face, arms, head (wiping), ears, and feet.

Q6. What breaks Wudu?

Answer: Using the toilet, passing wind, deep sleep, and bleeding, among other things.

Q7. What do we say after completing Wudu?

Answer: We say the Shahadah and a short dua asking Allah to make us among those who repent and stay pure.

Diagram: Steps of Wudu

1	Make the intention (niyyah) and say Bismillah.
2	Wash both hands up to the wrists, 3 times.
3	Rinse the mouth 3 times.
4	Sniff water into the nose and blow out, 3 times.
5	Wash the face from forehead to chin, 3 times.
6	Wash the arms up to and including the elbows, 3 times, right then left.
7	Wipe the head once with wet hands (Masah).
8	Wipe the inside and outside of the ears.
9	Wash the feet up to the ankles, 3 times, right then left.

CLEANLINESS IN ISLAM

- Cleanliness and worship

Answer: Yes, Islam teaches that cleanliness is very important; it is even called 'half of faith'.

Answer: Yes, we should wash our hands before and after eating.

Q4. Should we brush our teeth?

Answer: Yes, keeping our teeth clean is a good habit taught in Islam.

Answer: Yes, Muslims should keep their homes, streets and masjids clean.
