## Circular

Within the activities organised by the Committee for the Conservation of the Acropolis Monuments and the Acropolis Restoration Service in collaboration with the Ephorate of Antiquities of Athens and the Acropolis Museum, the 7<sup>th</sup> International Scientific Meeting will take place in Athens, from 11<sup>th</sup> to the 13<sup>th</sup> November 2021, on the subject of:

## "The restoration works on the Acropolis. The new Programmes"

The meeting will be hybrid, allowing both physical and virtual attendance.

The papers presented will firstly concern the works completed during the period between 2017-2020 and secondly the projects still in progress which are being conducted according to studies approved by the Central Archaeological Council. What will be mainly discussed though, are the proposals for the future conservation, restoration, and enhancement programmes of the Acropolis monuments.

If conditions allow it a visit to the Acropolis worksites will take place, during which specific issues will be presented.

Emphasis will be given to proposals concerning the restoration of the walls and the western access to the monuments. There will be a brief reference to the Parthenon project as a more extensive presentation will be organised in the future.

After the presentations time will be given to discussion, where the participants will have the chance to express their opinion on issues mentioned at the meeting and to the conclusions of the Meeting.

A questionnaire will be distributed to the participants in order to express their opinions about the restoration proposals.

The final programme of the Meeting will be announced in October 2021.

As in the previous Meetings, the Proceedings of the Meeting will be published.
