

TUCK THE VANITY INTO AN ALCOVE.

The integrated look of this remodelled bathroom by Victoria McKenney of Enviable Designs with Marino General Contracting was achieved with layers of stone that read as one: the vanity area is clad entirely in slabs of porcelain (Statuario Bianco by Antolini); the floors and walls are a large-format marble tile (Bianco Pearl from Aeon Stone and Tile); the shower floor is an intersecting white-and-grey Carrara marble tile by GL Stone. "The space is a blend of a few different design aesthetics," says McKenney, "but the overall look is quite transitional." Integrating the vanity keeps the design light and streamlined. "Floating shelves inside the niches is a nice way to bring up the warmth of the rift-cut white oak," she explains, "and create opportunities for display." WL
