1. Purpose of the Holidays

Our students have completed their FA 1 Examinations with dedication and discipline. These holidays are not merely for rest or leisure. Their real purpose is to help children:

- Refresh physically and mentally in peace
- Strengthen discipline and healthy routines
- Deepen family bonds
- Develop life skills and practical abilities
- Nurture noble character
- Benefit from the spiritual blessings of Eid ul Adha

With proper guidance, this period can become a powerful opportunity for personal growth and character formation.

2. The Importance of Noble Muslim Akhlaq

The foundation of true excellence lies in noble Muslim Akhlaq — refined manners, ethics, and character that define a true believer. This remains the core value we strive to develop in every student.

"I have been sent only to perfect good character." (Sahih Muslim)

"The best among you are those who have the best character." (Sahih Bukhari)

3. Suggested Daily Routine for Summer Vacation

Parents are kindly requested to supervise their children and ensure the daily schedule includes learning, discipline, physical activity, spiritual development, and family interaction.

- Wake up early, brush teeth, bathe, and maintain personal cleanliness.
- Recite Masnoon Duas upon waking.
- Offer Salah regularly (boys with fathers at the masjid; girls with mothers at home).
- Daily Quran/Qaida reading and practice.
- English conversation at home with parents.
- Writing practice: 1–2 pages daily in English or Hindi.
- Complete all holiday homework and projects (children must prepare their craft and project work themselves).
- Physical activity: Outdoor play, cycling, or light exercise (avoid playing in direct afternoon sun).
- Skill development: Drawing, basic stitching home-science, (for girls), simple household tasks, and helping parents.
- Daily family Taleem with all five amaals using authentic books such as Fazail-e-Aamal, Muntakhab Ahadees, etc. (observing purdah).
- Practice Masnoon Duas for eating, sleeping, entering/leaving home, and other daily activities.
- **Teach children to respond promptly with “Abbu Labbaik / Ammi Labbaik, Main Hazir Hun”, say “Jazakallah” when helped, and “Ameen wa iyyakum” in reply.**
- Greet others with Salaam, say Alhamdulillah when sneezing, and serve water to guests.
- Strictly limit screen time and mobile phone and TV, video games usage. Devices should be switched off early.
- Sleep early and maintain consistent routines.

Do's: Daily learning, Namaz, Quran recitation, physical activity, and helping with household chores.

Don'ts: Excessive mobile use, playing in harsh sunlight, idle time, or bad company.



4. Academic Expectations & Holiday Homework

- Submission Deadline: 29th and 30th June 2026 (no late submissions will be accepted when school INSHA.. Reopens on). St July
- Parents and children should visit the school only for homework submission.

6. Financial Reminder

- Grading (Total 20 Marks): Written assignments (10), Creative projects (5), Homework videos sending to teachers(5).

These marks will contribute to the term results.

5. Important – Birth Certificate & Aadhaar Card

Students without a Birth Certificate or Aadhaar Card will receive expulsion final admission cancellation letter letters on 20th June 2026 and will not be permitted to continue in the school. The school will no longer accept any negligence regarding this requirement. No readmission requests will be entertained. Any parent engaging in unruly behaviour on the premises will face formal complaints with the concerned authorities. Fees paid will not be refunded.

Please pay the May–June fees by the 25th of each month to avail the ₹50 discount. Else full paid will get paid and no discount will be givenA dditionally, pay ₹150 to the class teacher for the Identity Card. If not aubmitted lastly by 15th May 2026 .
