
Getting to know your Echo Dot



Also included: Power adaptor

1. Plug in your Echo Dot & wait for Alexa to say hello

Plug the power adaptor into your Echo Dot and then into an electrical socket. A blue light ring will begin to spin around the top. In about 1 minute, Alexa will greet you and let you know to complete setup in the Alexa App.



You must use the items included in the original Echo Dot package for optimal performance.

2. Download the Alexa App

Download the latest version of the Alexa App from the app store.

The app helps you get more out of your Echo Dot. It's where you set up calling and messaging, and manage music, lists, settings and news.

After you open the Alexa App, if you are not prompted to set up your device, tap the Devices icon in the lower right of the Alexa App to get started.





Optional: Connect to a speaker

You can connect your Echo Dot to a speaker using Bluetooth or an AUX cable. If you are using Bluetooth, place your speaker at least 1 metre away from your Echo Dot for optimal performance. If you are using an AUX cable, your speaker should be at least 15 centimetres away.

Where to put your Echo Dot

Echo Dot works best when placed in a central location, at least 20 centimetres from any walls. You can put Echo Dot in a variety of places—on a kitchen counter, the end table in your living room or a bedside table.

Talking to your Echo Dot

To get the attention of your Echo Dot, simply say "Alexa".
