If updating using v4.1.3, then EasyIP config file will work without the need of changing the Password

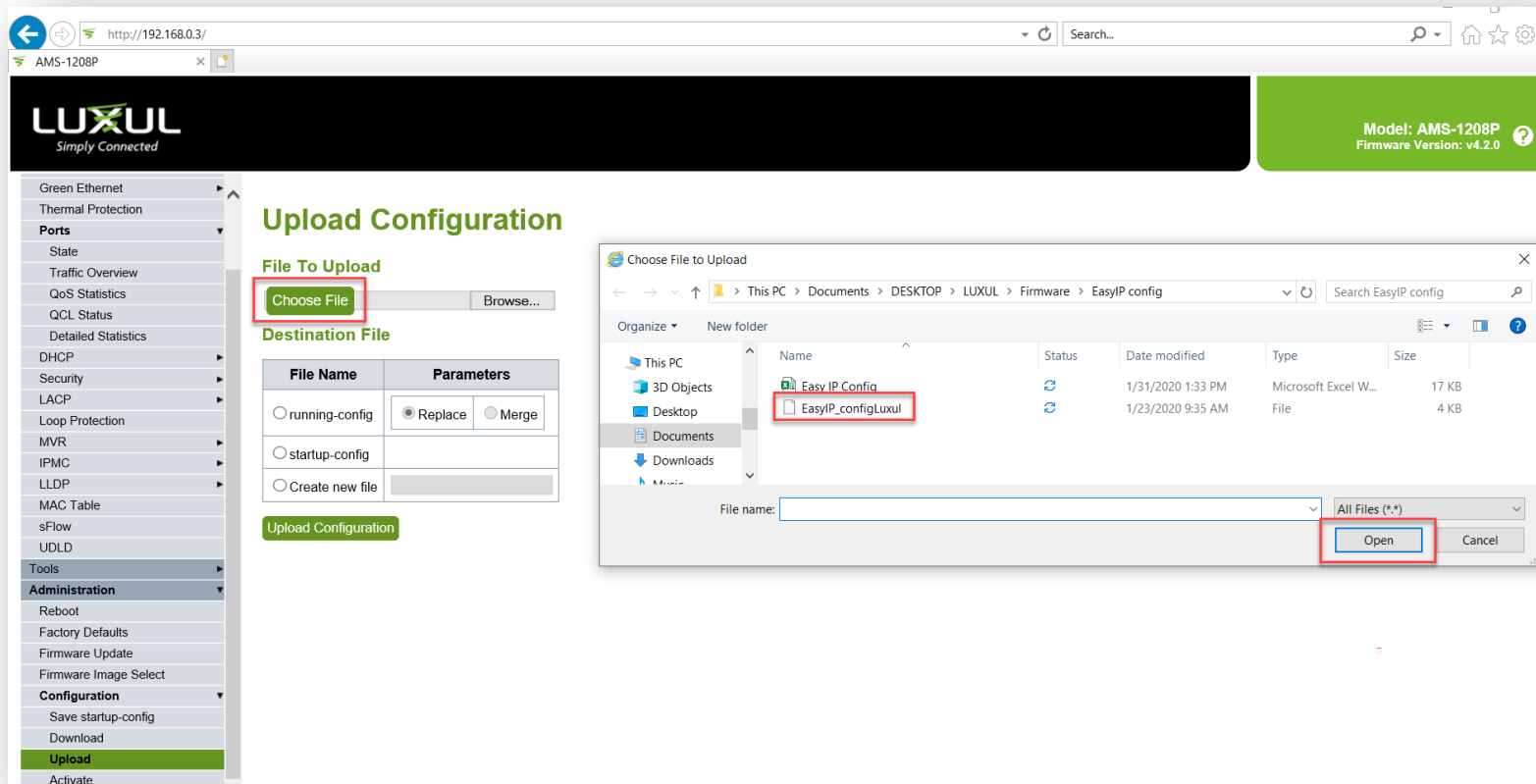

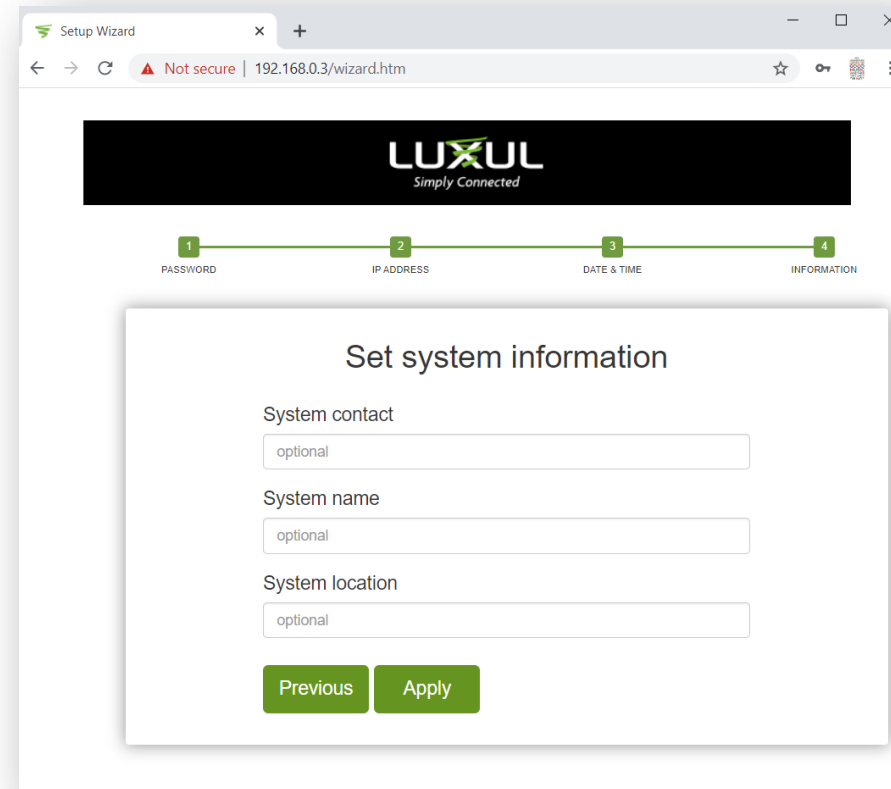
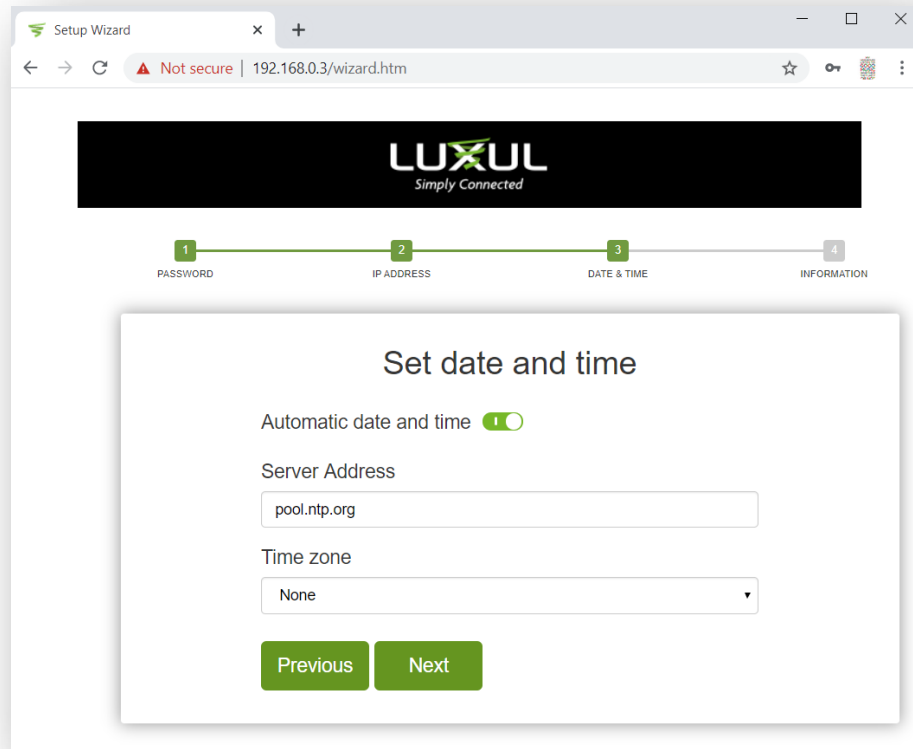
# EasyIP Config Update using Firmware v4.2.0

# EasyIP Config Update using Firmware v4.2.0

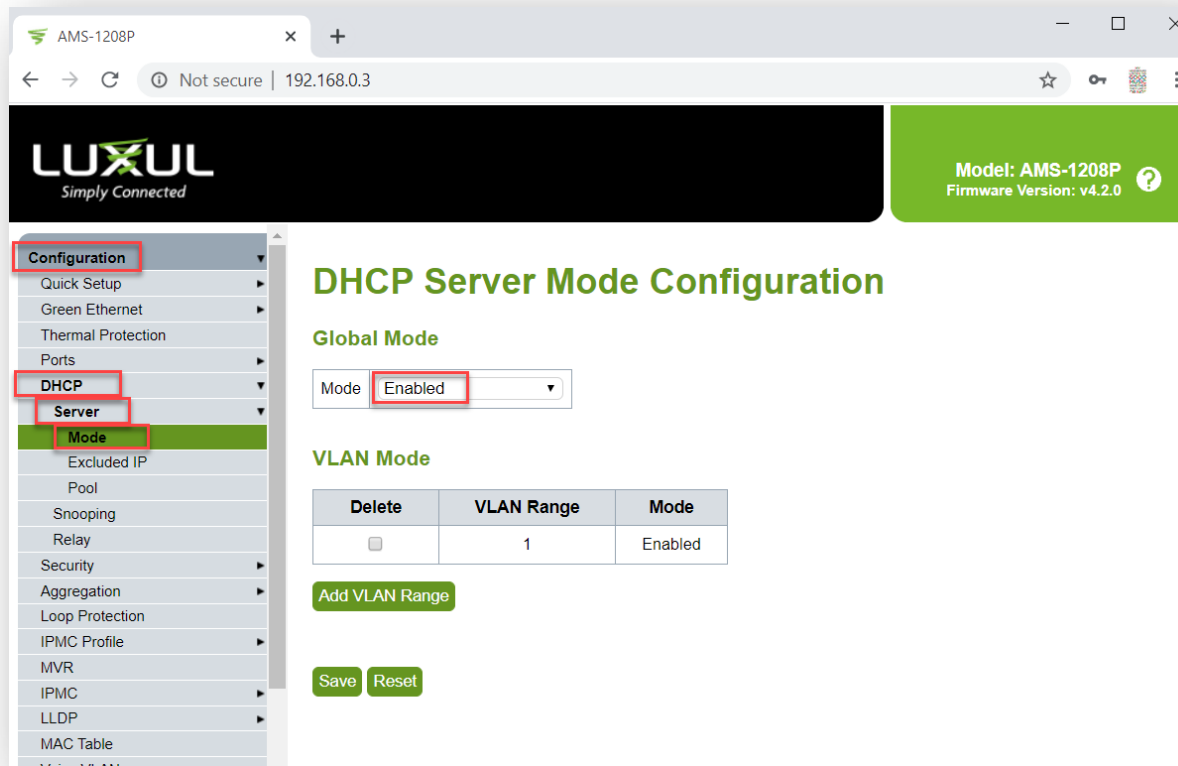
- Click on Next and Apply on the “Set date and time” and “Set system information” pop up windows





# EasyIP Config Update using Firmware v4.2.0

- You can confirm that the EasyIP configuration has been successfully uploaded by clicking on Configuration>DHCP>Server>Mode and checking that DHCP mode is “enabled” (it is disabled by default)
