## Panel of experts to discuss Road User Fees tonight in Ottawa Event comes on the heels of Ottawa focused report to be released this afternoon

March 28, 2017 -- Six experts, including the author of a report on congestion pricing's potential in Ottawa, will speak tonight at a panel discussion about how road user fees can help create sustainable transportation and liveable cities.

"Given that the City of Ottawa is proceeding with conducting an environmental assessment on a truck tunnel, which includes the possibility of it being a toll road, we felt it was timely for this conversation to be had," said Trevor Haché. "Other Canadian cities, including <u>Calgary</u>, <u>Edmonton</u>, <u>Montreal</u>, and <u>Vancouver</u>, and the <u>province of Nova Scotia</u>, are discussing similar ideas, and there is a wealth of international experience to draw on."

Organized by the Healthy Transportation Coalition and community partners, the event will include focus on a report (to be released later this afternoon) that studied different congestion pricing options in Ottawa. Issues of fairness and equity will also be highlighted, as well as lessons learned from the City of Toronto's recent experience.
