



## Backgrounder: Broten's plan to close the privatization ministry

## The Sask. Party's privatization ministry:

- In October 2012, the Sask. Party set up a ministry devoted to privatization, called SaskBuilds, to arrange their complicated P3 rental-schemes.
- The board of directors is made up entirely of Sask. Party cabinet ministers and MLAs.
- The annual cost for the privatization ministry is \$15.1 million.<sup>1</sup>
- The privatization ministry is wasting taxpayers' money. Even the Sask. Party's own skewed numbers show that costs for construction, operations, maintenance and rehabilitation are significantly higher with a P3 approach than with a traditional model:
  - o At least 3 per cent higher for the P3 schools.<sup>2</sup>
  - o At least 9 per cent higher for the Regina bypass.<sup>3</sup>
  - o At least 17 per cent higher for the Saskatchewan Hospital North Battleford.<sup>4</sup>

## Cam Broten will shut down the privatization ministry and save millions:

- By shutting down the privatization ministry, we'll save about \$15.1 million per year, for a savings of \$62 million over four years.
- Half of this funding will be redirected to rebuild the Ministry of Highways and Infrastructure.

## Cam Broten will stop using ridiculous P3 rental schemes and save millions:

- Even the Sask. Party's own skewed numbers show that costs for construction, operations, maintenance and rehabilitation are significantly higher with a P3 approach than with a traditional model:
  - o At least 3 per cent higher for the P3 schools.<sup>5</sup>
  - o At least 14 per cent higher for the Regina bypass. 6
  - o At least 17 per cent higher for the Saskatchewan Hospital North Battleford. 7
