On the first day of this year, a group of around 500 attacked a church in the neighboring state of Chhattisgarh. In recent days, the arrest of a Malayali pastor and his wife working in Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh was the topic of discussion in the media and political parties. Most of the congregations working in different parts of Madhya Pradesh in connection with our ministry are under severe threat. In some places it is not even possible to operate. We have a duty to pray for such areas and for the evangelists who work there even at the risk of their lives. The prayer of each one of us is surely precious. India should know Christ. Our country should be rich in good things at every level.



Rewa Theological Seminary is a Bible School started by Pastor Joy Varghese (Joy Thonniamala) to free

people from sinful natures and social evils and make them good citizens of the country by spreading the message of the kingdom of God to the places where the gospel has not reached in India. God has already prepared the way for many evangelists to be trained and sent to the missionary field. Joy Thonniamala, who became an evangelist during his primary school studies, after his priestly studies, was engaged in evangelistic work in the southern states of Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh and almost all the northern states of India apart from his own home state of Kerala. In the meantime, he reached Rewa in Madhya Pradesh. Rewa, which was known as the capital city of Vindhya Pradesh, a famous state of postindependence India, has attracted attention on many levels. Staying in Rewa for some time and getting to know the miserable life of the common people of Madhya Pradesh and nearby areas caused him to double his passion for the lost. While we are enjoying the unique

blessings of Kerala, which is famous for the beauty of nature, literacy and culture, the life of those people who could not even dream of this brought tears to his eyes. Believing that the gospel could bring change in the lives of the villagers, he formed the seminary to train the youth for that purpose. Courses like Certificate in Theology, Diploma in Theology and Bachelor of Theology are available here. Students from the northern states of India study here. The activities of the seminary are headed by Dr. Wilson Varghese, the administrator.
