While India is advancing in various fields such as science, technology, and medicine, the Christians and Christian activities here are facing many crises. This time the country faces so much persecution after becoming an independent republic.

Under the guise of the Prohibition of Religious Conversion Act, many people have been falsely charged and jailed throughout India. Recently Pastor Santosh Abraham and his wife Gigi were falsely accused and jailed in Dashana Jail Ghaziabad and go through many hurdles to get bail. Our brothers and sisters who are incarcerated are denied bail and prolonged jail time. When the bail days come, various reasons, like court strikes, condolence meetings, non-filing of police reports in almost all cases cause delayed bail. Most anti-Christians come forward to accuse praying and placing the Bible and other books related to the Bible in the temple as proselytizing.

In Manipur, the state with the highest percentage of Christian population in the country, the burning of Christian churches and a seminary has made the Christians in a state of panic and fear not knowing when or where the next violent attack is going to come. Forty-one percent of the people living there are Christians. Several places of worship, including three cathedrals built nearly five decades back, and bible seminary were also attacked. The violence has spread to the southern states of India. Karnataka State in South India is also going through severe violence and rage against Christians. The believers should pray sincerely for the eyes of the general public should be opened and to understand the horrific violence against Christians. Also, to see the Christians with empathy, and to deal with them with tolerance.

From the very beginning of the seminary, we arranged mission conferences for students and those working in different parts of North In-






