Your Niche, Sub-niche

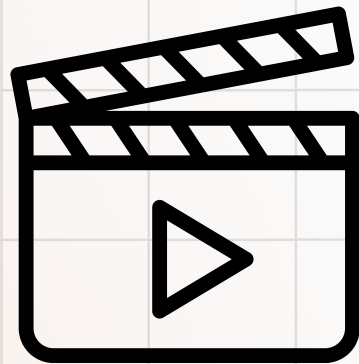

Vision & Foundation

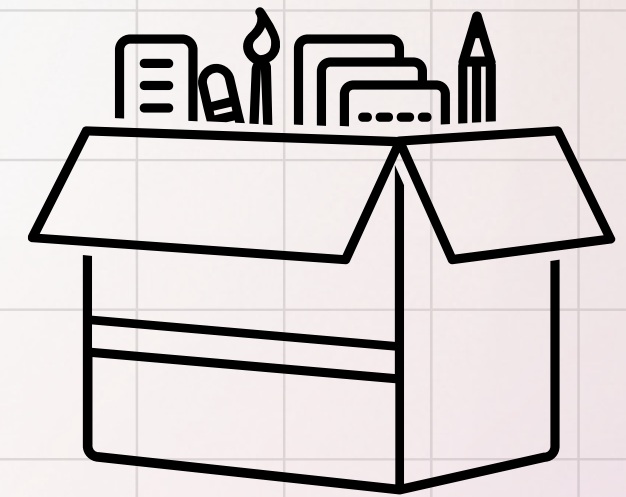
This is the first stage and we are going to setup your course. Its Outline, modules, your plan and etc.

Material Preparation

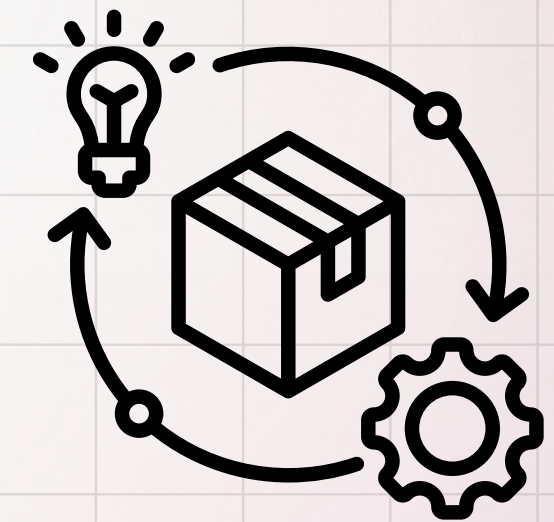
This is the second stage and we are going to start the text, image, video preparation for your course. just the raw stuff.

Course Production

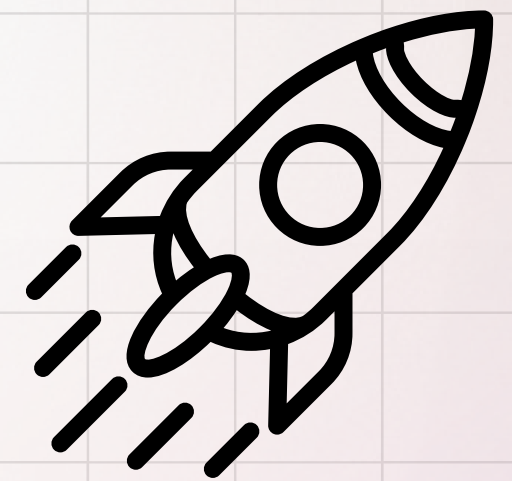
This is the third stage and we are going to start the production of your course. Like editing videos, slides, guides, etc.

Course Launch

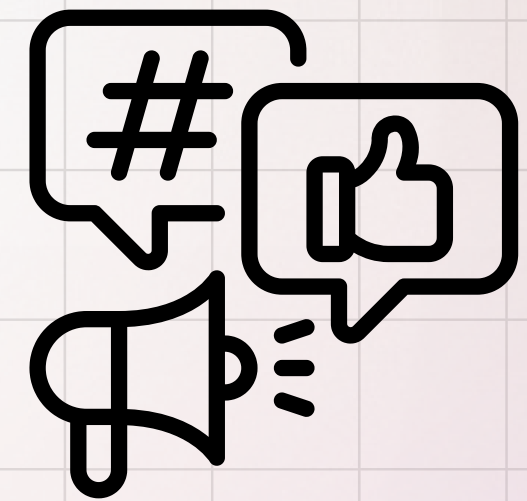
This is the fourth stage and we are going to launch your course on platforms like kajabi, gohighlevel, etc.
